Payment Terms

All fees are due upon registration. Payment options outlined in the table above. NSF cheques are subject to a \$30.00 fee payable to the Club. Members who submit NSF cheques to pay fees must pay future fees in cash or by certified cheque.

Registration Fees

Player fees cover athletic privileges with the Club and include two to five pool times per week depending on age group, coaching, club swimsuit & t-shirt, and registration with Water Polo Canada through the Alberta Water Polo Association. Travel to out of province tournaments (generally for U12 and older) is in addition to registration fees. We will provide guidance on travel expectations at the beginning of the season.

Siblings who register with the Club, receive a 20% discount. Any discounts will be applied to lower priced fees in the event siblings are subject to different rates. *No discount for entry pups*

All forms must be completed and all payments submitted for this registration to be validated and accepted.

All members of the Club are expected to participate in ALL the following:

1. Assigned Casinos & Bingo shifts

Our club relies on the funds raised from participation in casinos and bingos. We are fined, and therefore lose money, if we are unable to fully staff our casinos and bingos. As part of your fundraising commitment, you will be assigned a minimum # of bingos/casino once the fundraising schedule has been finalized (typically this is 2-4 bingos and 1-2 casino but is dependent on the # of members). The preference and expectation is that members work the bingos/casinos themselves.

If you are unable to work your assigned shift, it is YOUR responsibility to find a friend, family member or acquaintance to help you meet your commitment. You will be charged \$110 per missed bingo/casino commitment.

Full Season Withdrawal Policy

Partial refunds are available for full season registrations only if you no longer wish to continue membership. To withdraw from the Club, you must give two weeks' notice in writing to the Board through the Club Registrar (registry@wildwaterpolo.ca). Any refund shall be calculated from the date of the receipt of such notification as follows:

On or before Sept 30 of the registration year – 50% refund of registration fees

On or before Dec 1 of the registration year – 30% refund of registration fees

After Jan 1 of the registration year – 0% refund of registration fees

For any withdrawal after September 30, fundraising commitments (i.e. bingo /casinos AND fundraising) will still need to be met. If you work your assigned bingo / casino shifts you can choose to pay the \$200 fundraising 'opt out' fee. If you don't work your bingo/casino shifts and do not fulfill your \$150 fundraising requirement, you will be charged the \$500 volunteer / fundraising commitment fee per the credit card information above. Costs of apparel and other items provided with the registration package will be deducted from any refund and all access cards must be returned to the Registrar. There will be NO refund of any travel credits earned as travel credits have no cash value.
