

Calgary Wild Water Polo Registration Package For 2019-2020

The Calgary Wild Water Polo club is a competitive high-performance water polo club that provides training for girls and boys aged 6-18. Our mission is to develop athletes through competitive high-performance water polo programming and to teach fair and sportsmanlike conduct.

The Calgary Wild Water Polo Club trains out of the modern aquatic facilities of the Repsol Sports Centre. The club is affiliated with the Alberta Water Polo Association (AWPA) and Water Polo Canada (WPC).

The Calgary Wild Water Polo Club is a not-for-profit club that operates under the Societies Act of Alberta. As such, the foundation of our club is based on parent volunteering and fundraising.

The Calgary Wild strives to provide the best water polo coaching and training in the city. Along with the costs associated with training at Repsol, scarce pool availability, and the need to keep coach-to-athlete ratios in line with our vision of high-performance training, we may need to limit the number of players per age group team in order to maintain the level of high-performance training we want to provide our Wild athletes (applicable only to our 16U and 19U boys' teams). However, with our younger age group teams, our programming is very much focused on high participation and the introduction of water polo for all skill levels.

Program Package and Pricing

Early Registration Discount

Please note that we will offer a **10% discount** (to a maximum \$100 per athlete) for all registrations received **before June 30, 2019**. In order to qualify for the 10% discount, you must submit your registration package plus a \$200 deposit per registered athlete by June 30, 2019 (1 athlete = \$200 deposit, 2 athletes = \$400 deposit, etc.). The \$200 per registered athlete deposit will be applied against final payment. **If you do not follow-through with registration or final payment, you will forfeit the \$200 deposit per athlete.** This discount does not apply to 10U Pups registering for a single term.

Multiple Athlete Discount

For families registering **more than 1 athlete** (athletes must be from the same family), you will receive a **20% discount** per additional athlete registered. The 20% discount applies to the athlete(s) with the lower registration price(s). This discount does not apply to 10U Pups registering for a single term.

Included in the Registration Fee

Pool rental, coaching, Community League, Provincial League, Alberta Water Polo Membership fee (including athlete insurance), a Calgary Wild water polo swimsuit, and a Calgary Wild team t-shirt.

Tryout Policy

As discussed above, if we have more players register for the 16U or 19U boys' teams than we can accommodate (15 players: 13 field + 2 goalies), we may need to restrict the number of athletes on that particular team. If so, the age group team coach will hold tryouts within the first 2 weeks of the season to determine which athletes will be chosen for that age group team. If an athlete is not chosen to be on the team, we will provide a full refund for that athlete. Furthermore, we will work diligently with the athlete and his family to place the athlete on another better-suited team in Calgary.

Athletes **may** have the opportunity to play in the age category above their registered age group based on Coaches' evaluations and discretion.

Registration

We hope that the Calgary Wild's water polo programming is of interest to you and your athlete(s). If you wish to register your athlete(s), please carefully read the contract and agreements below and acknowledge with your signature.

Registration Contract

In consideration for the Calgary Wild Club agreeing to provide a position on an age-group team for the athlete(s) listed below, you confirm that you have read and understand the club's regulations and agree to comply with them all. Specifically, you agree to accept financial responsibility for the full fees of the athlete(s) you are registering. You have provided below a credit card, in good standing, and you give the Calgary Wild permission to charge your credit card for any monies you have outstanding to the club.

Fundraising and Volunteer Obligation Contract

As members of the Calgary Wild, parents are expected and obligated to participate in fundraising efforts throughout the year, primarily through bingos, casinos, raffles, and bottle drives. Parents will need to work a minimum number of bingo shifts determined by the club. The number of bingo shifts parents will need to work will be a function of the number of Wild families and athletes registered in relation to the number of bingos assigned by the AGLC. If the AGLC assigns our club a casino during the year, parents will be obligated to work a casino shift. Parents will be obligated to sell a minimum number of tickets for our yearly AGLC sanctioned raffle. Parents are expected and obligated to volunteer as minor officials at all Community League, Provincial League, AWPA sanctioned, and Water Polo Canada sanctioned games. Parents are obligated to assist with all club operations. You will provide a credit card, in good standing, to the Calgary Wild and you give the Calgary Wild permission to charge your credit card an amount determined using the table below for any missed or shortfall of fundraising and volunteer obligations.

Bingo Shift 1 Credit = Single Shift (AFT or EVE) 2 Credits = Double Shift (EVE/LN)	\$150 per bingo credit short of the minimum bingo credits needed (as determined by the Calgary Wild at the beginning of the season). Typically, the requirement per family is 4-6 credits.
Casino Shift	\$300 for not working or missing a casino shift
Raffle	Minimum raffle ticket sales are \$150 per family. You must pay the difference for any shortfall.
Minor Officiating and assisting with club operations	Up to \$200 as determined at the sole discretion of the Calgary Wild.

Personal Information Agreement

You understand that the Calgary Wild collects personal information about each of its registrants, including name, address, email(s), telephone number(s), sex, age, and date of birth. This information is used for the purposes of club communications and coordination. The information is also used by and disclosed to the Alberta Water Polo Association (AWPA), Water Polo Canada (WPC), and Sport Canada for annual demographic reporting, registration and rosters, age group determinations, and to communicate with participants about water polo programs, events, and activities. Medical information you provide will be given to all team coaches and in the case of team travel, to the assigned trip chaperone(s).

You understand that by registering, you consent to the use of your personal information by the Calgary Wild for its operations. Furthermore, you confirm you will not use personal information disseminated by the Calgary Wild for purposes unrelated to club functions.

You understand that the Calgary Wild, other water polo clubs, the AWPA, and WPC have a valid interest in taking photographs, videotape, and digital recordings of athletes during regular practices and competitive water polo activities. You consent to the use of these photographs, videotape, or digital recordings in any and all media to promote the Calgary Wild and the sport of water polo. You waive any rights of compensation and ownership thereto.

You consent to allowing the photographs, videotape, digital recordings, and performance results of your athlete(s) to be posted on the Calgary Wild, AWPA, and WPC websites or other media venues.

Competitive Schedule Commitment Agreement

The Calgary Wild are a competitive high-performance water polo club. As such, we expect athletes playing on teams competing in Provincial League, 14U NCL Westerns, and WPC's National Championship League (NCL) to attend all scheduled games – these games are **not** elective.

Code of Conduct Agreement

You acknowledge and certify that you and your athlete(s) will conduct yourselves in accordance with the Calgary Wild's Code of Conduct. You also acknowledge and certify that you and your athlete(s) will conduct yourselves in accordance with the Alberta Water Polo Association's and Water Polo Canada's codes of conduct.
